These pieces from Harry Williams are of uncertain date - they come from the 24 years between the publication of his autobiography 'Some Day I'll Find You' in 1982, and his death in January, 2006. Published posthumously, they form his testament.

Insofar as they relate to a now vanished world, it can be said that with that world have disappeared many of the targets at which he aimed. Nonetheless, so much of his prophetic wisdom relates not so much to the transient world of ecclesiastical fashion, as to the very real and present concerns of our continuing inner selves.

Broadly, the book can be recommended to two (hopefully grateful) constituencies. It can be a refreshing reminder to those who found in his published sermons and addresses as they became available, of the delight, relief, joy, that here was a voice which spoke the truth in a time of confusion. It can form an introduction to the work of a major prophet in the late 20th century Church of England.
