Your watch around us while we sleep.

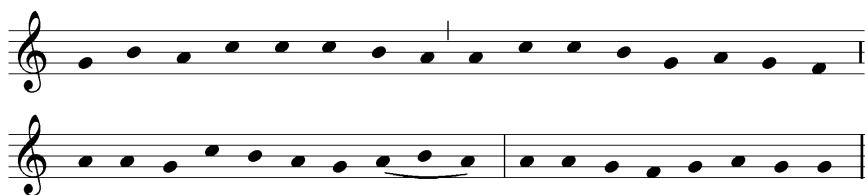
From evil dreams defend our sight,

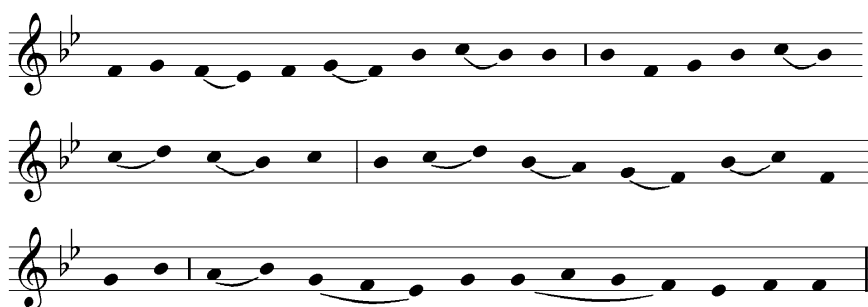
O Father, that we ask be done

May work our profit and your praise.

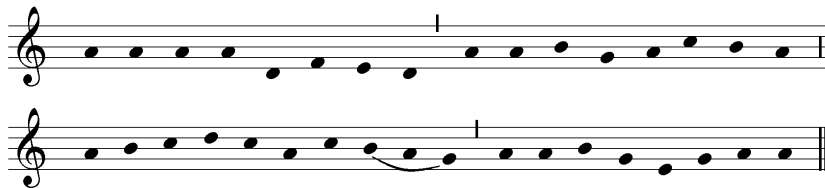
Passiontide
